

Show all work and simplify all answers before circling/boxing them. If you do the problem incorrectly, or don't show sufficient work, you will be asked to rewrite the problem for full credit.

Due next class. Students who turn assignments in late (or do not attempt a problem) forfeit their ability to rewrite those problems for credit.

- (1) Graph $x + 2y = 4$ using x and y intercepts
- (2) Graph $\frac{x}{3} - \frac{y}{2} = 1$ using x and y intercepts
- (3) Graph $y = 3x - 2$ using any method
- (4) Graph $y = \frac{3}{4}x - 1$ using any method
- (5) Graph $-2x + y = 6$ using any method.
- (6) Graph $5x + 15y - 30 = 0$ using any method.
- (7) Determine the slope of the line through $(1, 2)$ and $(4, 8)$, then find the equation of the line.
- (8) Determine the slope of the line through $(5, 2)$ and $(1, 4)$, then find the equation of the line.
